Bible Text: Ephesians 1:3

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Let's open up our bibles back up to Ephesians Chapter One, and I'm thanking the Lord for this precious encouragement He has, the masterpiece of grace in Ephesians, and how wonderful it's been as God has taken us in just a little bit deeper, honeys, I want you to have more praise God. Reading tonight from verse three let's just get right into it. Chapter One. Having predestinated us; here we go unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of his Will. Oh my, Lord let me see Your face praise God. Isn't that marvelous? I'll tell you this next provision that we're speaking of tonight all coming from the promise of what the Father gave us in the Son. In giving us Jesus He hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in the heavens in Christ. 0135 And this is because Jesus Christ, the Lamb slain before the foundation of the world. So, all of this plan, all of this wonderful work God saw completely finished in His Son before there was anything in beginning.

We see that from those, that wonderful encouragement that we have been blessed with all spiritual blessings in the heavens in Christ even speaking of these six provisions that have flowed from this encouragement that God has given us. And we're thankful that last week we found that He has chosen us in Him. Isn't that glorious? Just glory. But now tonight He has predestinated us, and He's done that. This is even the more grace brothers and sisters chosen and set apart in love. And we love that, isn't that marvelous, He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, and He set us before Him in love before the foundation of the world, but it's even more. We're predestinated, and thanks be to God predestinated means decided beforehand, and predetermined of God. Praise God. And He's speaking here of how He has chosen us in Him, how He set us before Him in love in Him, how He has predestinated us in Him, and once again in beginning. Before anything this grace abounded, this plan of grace praise the Lord was everything, and everything else followed after that. That's why I loved what we touched upon last week. Before the foundation of the world and before He set a star in heaven what that's truly speaking of is before the world even had a sick spell, before Satan was ever cast out of heaven, before all of that wickedness, before the fall of Satan before he exalted himself above God. But brothers and sisters let's never forget this is all because of the foreknowledge of God. See, the Father knows, and He surely does know, it's all because of His foreknowledge. Because God, I love this, He offers to all everything, He does but God also knows not only will not all accept Him, not all will go. Amen and He knows who won't. But God in us is what we're speaking of tonight, and specifically God and us in Christ. And all we can say is we are predestinated of Him.

I gathered with the saints that praise the Lord it's been decided beforehand. Are you resting in that? Praise the Lord, it's been decided beforehand; we're talking about the predestination, the predestinated in the redetermination of God. Now we're chosen, by the grace of God we're predestinated, That means in that predestination there's a divine guiding and leading in all the before ordained good works that we should walk therein tailormade purposed in every single one of us. See this is the God that tells us that He knows the hair on our head, He knows our thought afar off, amen? Why do you think He tells us these things? To let us know He knows that. And then as we know the word of God He formed us, He made us, and by His grace He knew us in Him before anything ever started. And all things are for your sake, all things are yours, so I thank the Lord how the Holy Ghost puts all that stuff together, that line upon line, and line upon line, and precept upon precept, and precept upon precept, praise God it's all about His love to us. It's all about Jesus the lover of our soul. It's all about this great love wherewith we are loved, praise the Lord.

You can read one verse and it can blow you away, but by the grace of God take the whole council of God and you just disappear and that's the beautiful part. That's why I'm so thankful for this time, and I'm thankful for what we have in the power of His might, and this wonderful Holy Ghost that guides us into all truth, not just bits and pieces, the Lord has given us everything. He's blessed us with all spiritual blessings in the heavens in Christ, He wants us to know the totality of what He has for us, who we are in Him, the value that we are. That everything was formed and made, and created for you, and not just done in some way that it's for you, and this is nice, there's a specific purpose of what you are to Him, and matter of fact it's called everything. Just as He's everything to us, you are everything to Him, and that's the truth and this is how this will take us tonight. But see, this predestination, this predetermination that God, He gave us such specific detail for our life to perform exactly, exactly what He wants to have performed, exactly what He wants accomplished in you, exactly what will be perfected in you.

Grace to God isn't some iffy thing, it's the most powerful thing there is. It's everything because it's Him; Jesus Christ full of grace and truth. That grace will perform this, that's why He said we have all grace. That's why we go boldly to the throne of grace, amen? And we obtain that mercy, He knows who He's dealing with, He's given us all grace, we just go to that place where it's revealed to us. Revealed to us in every need, and every moment. He made us tender vessels brothers and sisters, broken reeds, bruised reeds that He will not break amen? Smoking flasks that won't quench that were

weak and were weakened in the way tor that fellowship by the grace of God to be at that throne of grace. See, we're all in a place right now, and all the things we've gone through, the things we're going through that's why we're listening to this tonight, This is what He was planning. I'm just telling you; He didn't even have time to think, He didn't think about the heavens and the stars, and all that, it's just there. He thinks about you, He's been thinking about you, He's been planning about you. This the One that just speaks it into existence. He didn't just speak you into existence; oh no, it was as growth that had to happen, it was time that needed to happen. All these different things. All of this world, everything that He's given to us.

And then most importantly the word of God coming forth for us. And then the patience that the Lord had for us even on our moment that we accepted Christ, it's been in the last for the group in here, my mom's probably the oldest one here tonight, say in the last almost ninety years. Good thing the Lord waited for us to give us the Holy Ghost. This time that we would come in to have this fellowship with Him to yay, the deep things of God. Praise the Lord. This is what He waited for, this is what time was even made for, is for us to have this time with Him.

Now, all these provisions, everything from the very beginning, brothers and sisters He has done for us, and He has made those before foreordained good works that we should walk therein. And walk therein, now think of this, as the life as the chosen of God you're not walking through those before foreordained good works as you know just a person or something of that nature, you're the chosen of God. You're walking with the full backing of grace; you're walking as the elect of God. I know you don't feel like it and that's just fine, but by faith you'd better know it. Why wouldn't we, by the grace of God that's what faith is. That's what true faith is, it's bold in Him, not bold in you. I'm bold in the faith in the believing Christ loves me. He'll never depart from me, He doesn't see any fault in me; He does not. There isn't, He sees me, He sees His son the Father. Jesus sees me, He sees His bride. That's what He sees, He loves me, He's drawn to me. I don't disappoint Him; all He wants is more of my fellowship. All the time that I think that I've hurt Him, or done this and whatever, I always appreciated that like it's like I'm hugging and He's scratching His head; what are you talking about.

How long did it take you to forget those things which are behind? You better be running right now. I'm thankful to God that we had a pastor for years that taught us that. And I could see the passion and the reality, and the truth that by the grace of God, and by the power of the Lord he tried to get us to see that only the Holy Ghost can do that. The sadness, the concern, the times and all of that, but yet you know what, He had to rest for us too just like His own wife. And thanks be to God He's brought us into this place. But all of this is done in Him in beginning, and that's the more grace brothers and sisters. Once again predestinated the provisions of everything to super abound in grace in everything. Do you have the provisions for everything to super abound in grace in everything? Oh yes you do, I'm sad if you don't think you do, but you do, and that's what

the mature sons of God believe, and they know, and they cherish that He did it in Him in ages past. I've had this since beginning in my Lord.

Now, once again the love, the care, the divine obsession with us He is in love with us, and nothing else. You're it. You're it, this is what He loved, He loves you. He loves you; He adores you; you are it to Him. We can fantasize and think He loved this you know the plan is He loved the wildlife and all that. He made them, it's beautiful, but He made them for you. Yes, He did. Everything in this creation is for you. Don 't listen to what this old world, this world is evil; got it all completely upside down; all twisted, but see if you don't know the word of God you'll be twisted right along with it and there's no reason to be, it's just an attack, and attack, and attack. But He provided everything for us to grow up into Him in all things. You talk about putting us in an environment to grow up fully perfectly in everything, sometimes we think oh my goodness, how could that be, how is this going to work? I'm going to be injured so greatly, this was so detrimental to my life there's no way out of this. The story of every single life of every single one of our brethren was exactly that. The Lord showed us time, and time again there wasn't any looking for Him, He was the One that always He chose them.

Abraham wasn't looking for Him, none of them were looking for Him; grace found them. Grace drew them, there was no goodness in any of them, and then praise the Lord as God would continue to show them over and over whether it was the life of Joseph; why would God do those things to him. Why would God pluck him out of this family, a godly family. I'll tell you what, the Lord showed you it's his own brothers were the ones that were the worse to him. That can show you very clearly about what Christians can do. God help us that we would never be like that. That they can be the most discouraging, they can be the most hateful, they can be the ones that'll try to get you off track more than anything. But let me tell you something, you're the elect of God, and God will preserve you. And then you think how He took him, and He took him out there and put him in slavery, thought he was moving up through that Potiphar's house and doing good, and then bam, and bam, and bam. Why would God do that? Because God wanted him to reign. Why would God do that to Job? Because God wanted to give him a double portion. Amen.

Why would God do that to all of these precious ones like Ruth? Why would God take her father-in-law, and her husband, and her sister-in-law's husband? Huh? Because I want you to marry the redeemer. You see the pattern over, and over, and over; I've got more for you but it ain't going to come the way you think it is. It doesn't come in this pretty little package; we're going to talk about something Sunday that's going to blow you away. I'm just telling you so He's so after us right now it's going to be gone, gone, this time's going to be over, thank You Jesus. But every single time this is what He does, and the Father knows exactly what He's doing.

Now, He provided everything for us to grow up unto Him in all things, and once again that's everything. Every success of your life, every failure of your life tailor made by

Him; perfectly made by Him. He knew everything Jacob was going to do, He knew everything Tamar was going to do, He knew everything David was going to do; I write all of it in the word of God. Praise God, you know what it is, it's the word of God, and the word of God is the will of God. So I can see that He is the God that's with me in all my trouble. That was part of all the beauty of the before ordained good works that I could walk therein. Let me tell you something, you don't leave that stinking self-righteousness you're going to clipping one little pinky fingernail, and you're going to miss the trumpet blast because you thought you had one little thing to do. God help us not to do that. I want to be only found having His righteous, and I know what that is; it's nothing of me. I know that. I know what grace is, it's not my work. I know His grace has the most glorious work, I thank the Lord it's what gives me joy, it's what gives you hope. It's what puts the song in your heart, continues to have you to come to hear a message of Paul's gospel in spite of all the things that you have to face for it. There isn't anything else to do. Why would I go to church if I couldn't hear this?

I'm not kidding, I want this fellowship, I know what this is. I don't want that, Brother Hill used to say I know what butter is, I don't want margarine. You know that? I know what good steak is, I don't want bad steak. Now, it's all needed, isn't it? All of it, the word of God says in His faithfulness He afflicts us; He afflicts us. You know we talked time and time again; we've talked of Paul and how he knew the Lord. He drew so nigh to God because of the Lord's grace in drawing him in. I'm confident that Paul battled in body, the word of God tells it whether it was his eyes, his skin, different things about him, I'm sure those things we all know that; those things do wear on us, they're tough. But I'm confident because I've lived this life too, I know what is the most sensitive to this guy. I know a thorn that's deeper than any physical suffering thorn there is, and you do too. Now Let me tell you something, you think about the word of God telling us that that fiery trial that comes upon you, and it's coming, and you've got it because He wants you to win. But we don't think it strange because He tells us; He's prepared us amen?

Well, I think about my body, I live long enough it's going to get things, it is. You live long enough you're going to catch enough pretty much everything. Now, the Father knows, and He knows what will be offered and finished in faith in every life, so know that. He knows and He knew it in beginning. That's why those names come forth and that's why He does, He knows them by name, He calls them by name, and matter of fact He named them; oh yes, He did especially that dog Caleb last Sunday.

Now, here's what He knows, He knows this bridal calling is for you. That's what He knows, He knew that you think about this, He knew that the ark was for Noah, there wasn't another man, there wasn't anybody else, it was him. It was Abraham, it was, it was Rebekah, and I know what we see us as individuals, but He sees us all as one in Him. This is what He saw He saw for you, the bridal calling. Amen. Others in our family, they didn't hear these words of the Bridegroom's voice, and they don't hear it. They don't have that ear. He that hath an ear let him hear. You have that ear, thank God for that ear. Fight to thank God for that ear. Be humble, but see they didn't have it but you do, and He knows it and isn't that marvelous how God does those things, He places us all in a meeting to hear the Bridegroom's voice in preaching and teaching. Amen.

It's just what it is, that's why if I didn't know this message I could pretty well plug and play myself in most any Christian church; it's the truth. That's why people, they call it hopping. I can hop here and hop there, and go this one, and go that one you know until whatever because that's what my ear's in tune to. That's my taste, got milk. And I can get milk here, I can get milk there. But there's a certain strong meat, there isn't anything else that can compare to it and I thank God. And it's just like those restaurants you really like to go to there's not too many of them. You know what I'm saying. It's just God's grace honey, you know that and it's not to flatter

ourselves in any way, shape, or form. I mean the lowest of the least, come on let's everybody really just own it. Ber thankful with Paul, O wretched man that I am, I did not deserve this one bit. Time and time again He should have just quit on me naturally speaking. But spiritually speaking that could never be because with what I'm reading about here I had Him in ages past because He had me, praise God. This is what He tells us, we either step into it by faith or we're just going to struggle and wrestle with it until He come.

Now, let's really get this tonight, let's see why we know, and I mean we know this that He bestowed upon us all this beyond comprehension love because this is love that's just beyond comprehension; it really is, come on now, but we know it. See, that's the beautiful thing, it's by the Spirit, you know it. See, because the Spirit reveals the truth to you and you say well it's obvious, I'm it. It's obvious, this is all He's been thinking about since forever. Beginning this what everything is purposed for, it's me, He made me for this. He loved me for this, and then He made everything else to give me this, praise God we should be excited about this. But see, He bestowed all this beyond comprehension love all of His attention, all of this predetermined grace because He predestinated us, and we read this tonight. And how many times have we just read through this, He predestinated us to the adoption of children, and I'm going to tell us something, God help us to really know our bibles. The kings it says in the word of God; the kings, they search out a matter. They do, and this adoption of children brothers and sisters what's it's referring to there is He has called us and predestinated us and chosen us for not just to be His children, but it means it's from the word huios in the Greek which means mature sons. We were chosen and predestinated to be the mature sons of God. It wasn't just to be born, there was so much more. And it wasn't that this was the intent of it, it was what I predetermined it to be. 31:04

Now, who's going to stop that? I know Who's apprehended me, and His grace is causing me to apprehend this which is always been for me, and always been for you. I haven't already it, I understand that but He did for me. But He did for me, and I thank Him, and I'm relying upon Him, and that's why I better always rely upon Him because once again He said I will perform. When are we ever going to get through our head, I can't do anything. The lily doesn't toil, these are all things we love to say, the lily doesn't toil, the little clay doesn't get off you know the little surface and run and mold itself; it can't, I perform the good work which I began. I will perform the good work which I began, how much clearer could He tell us, truly? The Lord said I will perfect that which concerns you; do you believe He'll do that? I do believe He will do that. I believe He will do that in spite of what I do; He will in spite of me, grace. I believe grace is that powerful. It is, and that's why grace causes me to be still. This unruly thing that begins to boil up, grace causes it.

I'm sold out; stop. It's not because I want to be good, it's because of love. It doesn't compare with the love He loves me with. I don't need to do that, because He loves me. I don't need to defend myself. He loves me. You have a bone to pick with me, you talk to

my husband. I leave that business to Him. Oh, I thank God, and I thank God for you because you believe this. But see, this is what we've been predestinate to. The adoption of children means we've been predestined to be mature sons. Predestined not to just be born of God but predestined by the grace of God to be the fully grown up manifestation of the sons of God's Son, the masterpiece unveiled for all to see.

Go on back to Romans Eight, read from verse eighteen. As it says there as Paul is saying, for I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us and that's been predetermined. That glory wasn't something well I, grace was hoping it would come, grace knew it would come. So once again this isn't on the fly, it's what going to be. Praise the Lord, he just waited for it. He waited for what he knew would come forth from his grace. So it says for I reckon that the sufferings of this resent time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us, for the earnest expectation of the creature, and that means all creation. The expectation of everything; everything. Everything waited, here we got that waiting right, that's what that everything was for, it's time, all of this for what? The manifestation of the huios sons of God; the mature sons of God. So we can put this all together, it was for those sons that were predestinated from beginning. This is what this is all about. It's that unveiling. That's the apocalypse, that's the manifestation of all of this wondrous love and how we've been blessed with all spiritual blessings in the heavens in Christ. Praise God. 35:45

Now see, this is how wonderfully interwoven every line is if we just be encouraged in our hearts to really search out a matter. And you know what the matter that He's put in our hearts. Our matter is the high calling of God in Christ Jesus. And I thank the Lord that the Spirit takes us into this, and this is the bridal ones ordained good works that we would grow up into Him in all things and I thank the Lord, it's hidden here right in the word, praise God the adoption of children, it's more than what's on the surface, praise God it's being born for the sole purpose of being fully mature and growing up to be the Lamb's wife. And I thank God, here I am gathered with those because of that grace through faith I'm in the presence of them. Thank You Jesus. It is, you talk about an apocalypse, it's going to be unveiled, a bang, a boom, or whatever you want to call it praise God she is going to be made known, and once again it's all by grace.

Remember how we read that in Timothy? It was for the purpose of His grace, for the purpose of grace. The Lord loves to show forth and truly show off the revealing power, and beauty, and glory of His grace. So, what we're rejoicing is thank the Lord Christ in us the hope of glory. This is what we've been formed for, this is what He saw us for, the masterpiece of His grace. His grace where all the glory is, so that's why she descends from heaven having the glory of God; that's why she has that. That's why it's the glory that shall be revealed in us. And you notice it wasn't saying might be, could be, should be, uh-huh this is matter of fact with Paul because this wondrous message of the masterpiece of grace that grace is so masterful it was done in beginning. But that's why we can rest, and that's the very rest of God. That's how God doesn't worry about anything

because He saw everything was put where? In His Son. So where have we been put? In Christ, should we not have the same rest and peace as the Father if the Son has it all? He's got you; He's got you and this is what we're in Him with.

We're in Him with the fulness of this knowledge, the fulness of His grace knowledge, the fulness of His love knowledge. We've grown up. He brings the word to me, and I thank the Lord, He ministers it to me, and by the grace of God I minister it back to Him. I can point to where He's told me, this is Who you've made Me. I thank you there's mercy beyond, Your tender mercy divides forever, but I know who I am to You and all I'm here to do is to honor You, and I honor You back with all the grace that You've given to me which is every bit. And I know when I see You my love, I will be like You in the fulness in that measure, and that stature into a perfect man because this is the grace that has been promised to us. And by the grace of God, we believe this grace. Amen. 40:32

Now, the matter for us is to win, the matter for us is just to believe Him. We thank God that all of these things were created, all of this ordering was everything for us from creation to every event of our lives, brothers and sisters, know that about your life. Every event of your life, everything created for your life just as Rebekah was led right into the bridegroom's arms, it has to be everything. It has to be this country falling apart, it has to be the evil of man waxing worse and worse, it has to spiritual wickedness in high places. It has to be, but it wasn't just having to be for everything to wrap up. I used to think of it that way; it had to be for me. This had to happen to grow my faith to the fulness to be ready to marry Him. Amen.

Now, you think about this everything to Himself, everything for His own sake, everything for His good pleasure, this is God we're talking about. Now do you understand why Jesus said I have forgave your iniquities for My sake? I had to ransom you, I set it all up that way, I'm a romantic. See how He loves you? You're all going to see Him; I want to see Him with this faith. That moment that I see Him, the moment I see Him and I'm like Him in that fullness. And I'll tell you what, we're not going to be disappointed, but all of this is predetermined all in His Son full of grace and truth. The masterpiece of grace that He will present to Himself and He'll do that.

Now, just these few minutes we're going to wrap this up. I want us to think about, just take a little bit of time to bask in what He's shown us here Just in these few verses of Ephesians One. Now He tells us in verse four that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love. He says place this before Him in love, and then He takes us right to verse five and He said then He predestinated us and remember He's not predestinating us; having predestinated us. So once again this is all done alright? So, He chose us before the foundation of the world that we should be or exist holy and blameless before Him in love. So see, that's what He did and chose us in that so He could just bask in love having us right there before Him. Alright? And then having predestinated us unto the mature sons by Jesus Christ and I love that, to Himself once again for Himself. This is all for Him, oh yes it is He's God. But look what He said, according to the good pleasure of His will. So,

He set us before Him in love, and all for the good pleasure of His will and you need to find that out, that's His ecstasy. Once again that's His complete desire is what He's set before Him which is you in love, the plan praise God and predetermined plan that you're going to be this fully majestic, beautiful, completely flourished. He describes you in the Song of Solomon whether it's the neck, the eyes, the lips, the breasts; come on, that's what He's been looking at in love the good pleasure of His will.

And it's all for as it says there right in verse six, and He has to say it right there and He'll say it two more times too. It says to the praise of the glory of His grace. She will be and this is all for that she'll be that praise of His glory. That's right. Once again, the praise of His glory. Don't let that be a hard step, that's what this is. The glory that shall be revealed in you. Why is He going to reveal that glory? So, it can be praised. Why does He take the twenty-four elders and put them around you? So, you can be praised. As we give Him the glory that's revealed in us amen? The praise of the glory of His grace. See, that's what we've taken, all of this grace, all this grace. Well, the only thing that grace if you take all grace, the only thing that comes out of that is full glory, and that's why she descends from heaven having what? The glory of God. She's it, and then praise the Lord we'll talk about that on Sunday, and her light. And once again as we'll find out, once born of God that light was always there because it's Him.

So, in closing here we go. If we'll open up to these deepest words of love and His desire to us, and let Him love us, and let Him kiss us with the kisses of His mouth, now I'll tell you what, we'll be ravished with all the spiritual purpose of His love. Amen? And brothers and sisters with all this that we have been encouraged in tonight we're going to be fought, but once again don't doubt it. Think of God's assurances to us, I will perform the good work which I have begun in you. He would not have given you this bridal message proposal if He would not perform it. He would not have given Noah all the instructions of building the ark if He wasn't going to perform it. He wouldn't have had him build the ark if He wasn't going to bring all the animals. He wouldn't have had him build the ark if He wasn't going to bring rain, amen? He wouldn't have done everything to Joseph and brought him all those things if He was going to have him reign. Amen? He wouldn't have had Rebekah meet the servant if she wasn't going to say I will. And she would have never gotten on that camel. For I'm the camel, I get that but I'm in the camel train. This is the camel train, the bride message, she would have never gotten in that train if He wasn't going to take her all the way. 49:29

to keep that. Is the bridal message that? Oh yes, it is because He had to give you which you committed back to Him. I'm persuaded that He is able to keep that which I have committed unto Him against that day. Amen? You believe that now? Praise the Lord, praise the Lord, believe that now? Praise His name.
