Serving- requires no special talent or ability

Attitude of a Servant

- -The subject of serving can be taboo
- -Arguments about serving can be taken to two extremes
- -1. Serving can be viewed as a work of the flesh and is a self righteous act that should be avoided in order to focus on one's personal walk
- -2. When christians become saved they should immediately find out where they are needed for service. The primary focus of a christian should be serving. The most important thing a christian can do.

Jesus became a Servant

Mark 10:45, Matt 20:28, Phil 2:6-7

Mark 10:45, Matt 20:28- Minister (1247)= minister can be used a a synonym for serving

- Jesus the son of God explains that he did not come to man to be served (ministered) which would have be completely acceptable and deserving given who he is and who we are. Instead says he came to man to serve.

From God to man to servant

Jesus washes the apostles feet

A <u>yielded life</u> is what Paul refers to here as <u>"A Living Sacrifice"</u>

God wants you "Life Song" to sing

Living (2198) -to be alive

- To enjoy life
- *Living water, having vital power in itself and exerting the same upon the soul <u>John 7:38-</u> (which speaks to the power of the holy spirit to yield life) If we will but yield ourselves to the Holy Spirit and yield our tongue, we can be filled with the power of the Holy Spirit. And have this living water flowing from us
- To be full of vigour (fresh, strong, efficient, active, powerful)
