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## CAMP GUIDELINES

- Everyone staying on the grounds will be expected to attend all classes, services, and activities.
- The dress code will be enforced – see your “List of Items to Bring to Camp” for the dress code.
- No smoking or improper language is permitted on the grounds. Alcohol and drugs are absolutely forbidden and will result in immediate dismissal.
- All Campers staying in dorms (5th grade thru College) -- Do Not leave the grounds for any reason without notifying Jesse or Polly. We need to be able to locate you in an emergency.
- Walking and hiking within the Camp area is only permitted during the afternoon free time and must be in groups of two or more. If you are under 18 you must let your counselor know where you are going and when you expect to return. **Fourth graders and under must have adult supervision at all times.**
- No iPods, radios, computers, TVs, CDs, tape players, or electronic games are allowed. Neither are bicycles, roller blades or skateboards, etc. There is no cell service available at The Highlands Camp, please plan to leave cell phones at home. You may use the phone in the Lobby to make calls.
- Meals will be served at 7:45am, 12:00pm, and 5:45pm (commuters are served until 6:45pm).
- Water balloons, shaving cream and pillow fights are not permitted.
- After the evening service, campers may gather and fellowship in the Meeker Lodge, or the dorms until 10:15pm. Campers are to be in their rooms by 10:30pm and lights out is at 11:00pm.
- BOYS ARE TO STAY AWAY FROM THE GIRLS DORMITORY BUILDING AND GIRLS ARE TO STAY AWAY FROM THE BOYS DORMITORY BUILDINGS **AT ALL TIMES!!!!**
- Do not leave valuables in your room at any time. Keep them with you or give them to an adult for safekeeping. Respect other’s property. Do Not touch or use someone else’s things without asking first.
- All campers and visitors are expected to know, understand and abide by these guidelines. Violation of these guidelines or any disrespectful or rebellious attitude toward authority will be grounds for immediate dismissal from the Camp.
- If you have any questions, concerns, problems, or suggestions, please bring them to Pastor Jesse O’Dorisio – that’s what he is there for!

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## CAMP DRESS CODE & LIST OF THINGS TO BRING TO CAMP

### CAMPER/COUNSELOR - DORM LODGING

- Bible, notebook, pen, flashlight
- Blanket and sheets (twin size), pillows, and/or sleeping bag (blankets and pillows are not provided)
- Washcloth, towels, toiletries (toothbrushes, soap, shampoo, etc.)
- Sunscreen, hat, bug repellent, electric fans
- Dress Code (clothing needs to be conservative, no inappropriate t-shirts)

Church Clothes – *please understand the idea behind this is modesty and consideration for others. This is to minimize distractions.*

**GIRLS** -- Slacks, jeans, skirts, dresses. Skirts and dresses must not be shorter than four inches above the knee, cannot be tight or with big slits. No bare midriffs, halter tops, etc., no undergarments showing (bra straps), no spaghetti straps unless covered by an outer shirt. No low-cut dresses or blouses (no breasts showing), no belly buttons. No bare shoulders.

**BOYS** -- Nice jeans or slacks. Shirts must be clean, not faded, no holes. Preferably dress t-shirts or button-up shirts; wearing t-shirts is discouraged for church services. Shirts “tucked in” are encouraged.

#### Play Clothes:

Shoes - hiking shoes, tennis shoes, boots, etc.

Modest shorts, crop pants, capris, jeans and t-shirts are recommended. Those wearing short-shorts and/or tight-fitting, low cut tops will be asked to change. The Highlands staff recommends jeans for the environment. **NO TIGHT FITTING ATHLETIC WEAR (i.e., spandex shorts/pants, yoga pants)**

**BOYS** -- No sleeveless shirts for boys or men.

**ATTN: NO SHORTS IN MEEKER LODGE DURING EVENING CHURCH SERVICE**  
**appropriate shorts are acceptable during class**

- Bring at least two pairs of shoes, we recommend one pair for hiking
- Sweatshirts, jackets, rain ponchos, umbrella
- Money - Christian t-shirts and souvenirs are available that you can purchase
- Bring snacks for your rooms, also bottled water and a refillable water bottle with your name on it--you will need it! All food must be enclosed (mice, bears, etc.). **No perishable food in the dorms or cabins!**
- Twin size foam mattress “egg-crates” work great on the Dorm Lodging and Rustic Cabin bunk beds for you adults who need a little added comfort.

### FORMS

**REGISTRATION FORMS ARE NECESSARY FOR ALL GUESTS COMING ONTO CAMP PROPERTY!**

- HIGHLANDS CAMPER ACTIVITY RELEASE FORM - required for everyone – **must be turned in prior to the start of Camp or at registration**
- MEDICAL INFORMATION/RELEASE FORM - everyone coming onto the campgrounds must fill this out – **all children (18 years & under) must have this form signed by their parents**

### MISCELLANEOUS

- CHILDREN - 4th grade and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times
- RECREATION - frisbee golf course, air hockey, game & puzzle room, canoeing pond, foosball, ping-pong, hiking, nature trails, volleyball, crafts, etc. There is no swimming or fishing.
- ACCOMMODATIONS - children entering 5th grade and older in the Fall are placed in bunk rooms with counselors according to age groups. — Adults 18 years and older may serve as counselors or may be assigned to adult sleeping accommodations. — Parents with children 4th grade or younger are provided sleeping accommodations together.
