Part 2 of 3 O.T. Prophesies fulfilled by Jesus Christ during the Passover week, His crucifixion, and His resurrection.

Part 2: Prophesy fulfilled in the Crucifixion Jesus Christ our Savior.

- 1. Jesus fulfilled over 135 Old Testament prophesy verses during His lifetime. The requirement that God's complete, and absolute perfect will must be fulfilled in His Son was fully accomplished.
- 2. **Genesis 3:15**: "And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel." **Hebrews 2:14**: "Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil." This foretells Christ's complete victory over sin and death, and Satan upon the cross.
- 3. His blood applied to our hearts just as over the doorposts in Egypt is the atonement (washed away, removed, satisfied the requirement) for all our sins. **Exodus 12:13**: "And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye [are]: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy [you], when I smite the land of Egypt." **Romans 5:8**: "But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."
- 4. They struck Him and spat upon Him. **Isaiah 50:6**: "I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from shame and spitting." **Matthew 26:67**: "Then did they spit in his face, and buffeted him; and others smote [him] with the palms of their hands."
- 5. They pierced His hands and his feet. **Psalm 22:16**: "For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have inclosed me: they pierced my hands and my feet." **John 20:27**: "Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust [it] into my side: and be not faithless, but believing."
- 6. Not a bone broken. **Exodus 12:46**: "In one house shall it be eaten; thou shalt not carry forth ought of the flesh abroad out of the house; neither shall ye break a bone thereof." **John 19:33**: "But when they came to Jesus, and saw that he was dead already, they brake not his legs."
