My Cup Runneth Over – 12 Pastor O'Dorisio – July 16, 2025

Bible Text: Colossians 1:25; I Timothy 4:8 ...

He drew us, and He drew us yonder back for this praise His name. Now we go on in this Paul's overflowing cup, and that precious word that he often uses in the Greek ($pl\bar{e}ro\bar{o}$) is in abundance, and overflowing, and exceeding something that continues infinitely. And tonight, this is a very precious verse to us, maybe I believe one of our favorites in the word of God, and you find it in Colossians 1:25. And this exceeding, and this abundance is really the good pleasure of His will. Remember, He's God and this is His pleasure. And this is His will, and this is His as you look into this truly that means His ecstasy and that will be the wife for the Lamb of God.

And here's what does it, here's the blessing that we have, and we begin to read of this here in Colossians Verse Twenty-five. Paul says here, I am made a minister; isn't that something? Aren't you thankful that Paul didn't make himself; man didn't make him that, he was made of it by God. Amen. But he was made a minister according to the dispensation of God given unto me. Now, I'd like you to look at that dispensation. That means overseer, that means the domestic, and Paul is the master builder in this, and we're so thankful. Now, again we just follow Paul as He followed Christ, we know that it is Jesus Who gets all the glory. But there's a specific purpose with this chosen vessel 0204 named the Apostle Paul.

And you have to go back and think about his prior name was Saul. And the beauty about Saul is he is the chief of sinners. He magnified the most rank future to God that there could ever be, and that's self-righteousness. That's that pride, that's believing in any way, shape, or form that you want to be having your self-righteousness which is of the law; you do not want that, you do not want that in any way. And God took that one that was so much in magnifying himself, and his goodness and He showed us that yes, that even we can come to God's best, and it's all going to be one way, and that's by the grace of God.

So here we have this calling, this one that was made a minister, this chosen vessel unto God according to the dispensation, the overseer domestic that he was given this for us, and you notice it was given to me he said for you. And you put yourself right there, that's how personal this is. It wasn't for them, it wasn't for they, it was for you, and I thank the Lord that the word is alive today, and we know that this is our message and we hear this, and here's the purpose of it, it's to fulfil the word of God, and there's you word fulfil, there's your word (plēroō). There's the overflowing, the infinite, and actually remember this, it means to be presented perfect, complete in all these things. That's what the Apostle Paul does with the message that was given to him; that message that was given to Paul that's what the bridal message does, and it causes us to have this fullness, this glory that

fills the fulness of Jesus Christ. It fulfils the word of God; it fulfils praise the Lord Jesus Christ.

Now, I want you to think about this. I'm thankful for this because of this promise, this power, this provision, this profound opportunity that really is exclusive to us in this Church Age. When the word of God said in the eleventh chapter of Hebrews that we have a better thing, it's the truth; it is the truth, and here it is. We fulfil because of the grace of God to us, the word of God because Paul's gospel does this in us. Paul's gospel if we'll take this in its fulness brothers and sisters, it will grow us up unto Him in all things. It will cause us to grow to a place that of the measure, and the stature, and the fulness of Him unto a perfect man. I mean we're right in that place there of this perfection, this fulness that going to be presented to Him that make Christ Jesus complete. It presents us to the Lord to complete Him, and once again only Paul's gospel can produce this fulness in us. I thank God we heard this for years, if you plant corn you're going to get corn, if you plant beans you're going to get beans. If you plant Paul's gospel you will get the bride for the Lamb of God, and that's what you will get. And you won't get anything else. Thank You Lord Jesus.

You plant this mystery; you plant this mystery, we'll get there in just a minute; this revelation of the bridal message into your life, and by the grace of God believe it and remain confident. And what do you remain confident in? Think about this. I remain confident in the in-love love that Jesus Christ has toward me. See, that is everything is the in-love love; not just the love of Christ, but the in-love love of Christ, and that is your confidence. The confidence that you have is the Lord continues to reveal this to us is that in ages past He called, and He chose us. And in that foreknowledge of knowing who we are, and were in Christ, He predestinated us. He predestinated us in this wonderful magnificent before ordained good works walk that we would walk in. And I love that; I love to thank the Lord for it. I love to thank the Lord that it applies, and it's all covered by Romans 8:28, and we know.

Why do we know that? Because of the in-love love of Jesus, and we know, do you know a lot of people struggle with Romans 8:28? They still want to believe that oh no, it's only the times that you're yielding to God; it says, and we know all things. Why do you think those told you that? Because He's got you; He's got you perfectly. And then we go back and again just to rejoice in what we hear throughout the whole word of God, but especially in the hundred and thirty-ninth Psalm; He made our members. He knows our thought afar off. How many times did He show us in the word of God? It didn't matter, He loved those, He called them because He loved them, He chose them because He loved them. The likes of a Jonah, Jonah couldn't even throw himself overboard to kill himself; God already had the fish prepared. Jonah wasn't going anywhere but into the eleventh chapter of Hebrews. Samson was the same way. People I'm sure they said, oh you're throwing your life away. Look at that, you've never overcome that; you never overcome that, you've always had that in your flesh. You've always wanted those kinds of women, and you never gave it up and look what happened to your life and look there; you're dying

and all of that. You know that message never left him, and all he said was remember me and he wasn't going anywhere else but the eleventh chapter of Hebrews. 08:00

Do you see the pattern? Over, and over, and over, and over, Jacob didn't even want the inheritance, he said mom, you're pushing too hard. I don't want to go out there and trick dad, that just really feel comfortable. You get out there; it's yours son, God gave that to you. When are we going to get over what you look like, what you feel like? It's what God has graced your life to believe like, and that's the importance of it, that's what it is; He gave you that faith. 08:40 That's why you're here listening to this tonight. You want grace, you desire grace. Grace makes sense to you because you have the mind of Christ. You're not an enemy of it, you're not trying to fight against grace, you want grace by the grace of God. And you want more of it, and you want people to take it, and you want that love, and that in-love love to lift you up because, and lift your brother up because You know what it's done for you time and time again. He's the One that does that, and He shows the magnificence of that love in every bit of our life and, and especially in the lowest parts; especially.

So, we thank the Lord for this, but we are confident in the in-love love that Christ has had for us from the very foundation of the world, and praise the Lord it's that confidence in that love, that bridal love, that love of the spouse it transforms us from glory to glory into His image. And we fulfil Him; we complete Him as it says right here; we fulfil the word of God. That alive and working in us gives Him the completeness and fulness of His life. Brothers and sisters, it's the one requirement for the crown; the one requirement, and I always remember when John Hill came into the office on that day, and He continued to come in just like that on many days, but he came in with that smile and he said just one thing; one thing brother, and he'd smile like that. Just one thing, and that one thing is 2 Timothy 4:8 and Paul says it like this. And we'll back up just a little bit because we look at Paul's life and we're so thankful for the grace of God that was with him. And we're so thankful that he always pointed that it was all the grace of God that was with Him.

All those were kind of sizing themselves up and how good they were, and all the great things that they did, he said if you guys are going to boast, I'll outboast you, but I'm going to tell you, it's all filthy rags. It's all nothing but for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ. It didn't matter all of those things; it was the grace of God that was with me. He did it all and we're thankful God has given us that same faith of Jesus Christ, the faith of the Son of God that we give Him all the glory. And I thank the lord that He's doing that in our lives. But Paul says I'm now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand. I have fought a good fight; I have finished my course; I have kept the faith. Now, there's a lot of things he's saying that I have, I have, I have. But I want us to go back and we're going to think about this in just a minute with the mind of Christ, and everything he's saying here.

Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, the exalted rank of righteousness crown. The best of its kind of crown which the Lord, the righteous judge. Judging always for reward, and the greatest of reward shall give me at that day, and not to me only, but all them also that love His appearing. He tells you the one condition. He tells you the one requirement; loving His appearing. And that loving His appearing, do you know what that does? It causes you to have confidence in His love to you, and in that confidence of His love to you, and that revelation of this bridal truth to me, and the knowledge of my Husband Jesus and His devotion to me I'm ready to be offered. I don't say that in my confidence, I'm ready to be offered because of the grace of God that is with me. I'm ready to be offered by the grace of God knowing that if the Lord takes me home right now, I believe Him that He will perform the good work which He's begun in me unto that day. And if that day is today, praise be to God, it's going to be performed, and what's going to be performed in my life is, praise the Lord, as thou hast believed so be it done unto you. I heard those words, I heard those words, and I believe Him, and I believe Him today there will be a performing of those words. God's promises are yea, and Amen, what are you banking on, an if, a maybe. By the grace of God if we got to go in there, we're well able to take it now. That's the heart of an overcomer and it's not confident in yourself. Paul again is saying because I love His appearing. 13:36

I'm not afraid, I'm at peace not just to see God, I'm at peace praise God because my Husband loves me. And so, I'm ready to be offered. The time of departure is at hand. Isn't the time of your departure at hand? By the grace of God aren't we, are we listening? Do we believe the trumpet's going to sound? I understand He was getting ready to go, I get that, but there's more to this; it's deeper. And then He says in that praise God I know what He's completed. I fought a good fight, I don't need to compare myself amongst ourselves, I know one thing, the before ordained good works that He's put into my life that I walk in, and I by the grace of God will have the grace to be manifest in my life it's for one thing, to apprehend that which I am apprehended of. So, in that I know that love will cause me to be ready, it'll cause me to have a good fight, it'll cause me to finish my course, it'll cause me praise God to abide and finish in that faith all because of love, and all because of that one thing, I love His appearing.

How could we not love His appearing? When you know the word of His grace, when He appears you're going to be like Him in the measure, and the stature, and the fulness of Him. How does that grab you? You have a lot to love there to love Him with a body, and fulness, and maturity like unto His own forever? And then the exceeding of the riches of His grace and His kindness just pouring forth to us? It's just over the top but that's the lover of our soul. But we're thankful see, that's what first love performs, and first love performs everything in you; it does. It's first love, it just does it because you believe in your husband, you believe in your spouse, you trust him. Don't you trust hm? Are you confident in him or are you just not, are you going be confident in you, and want to be more confident; you don't want to be more confident in you. You just want to be confident in him. He's wonderful, and I'm good. You know what I'm saying? He's wonderful, I'm good alright? So, that's how we understand this.

Now, I want you to think of this. The much the more that Paul is even saying in this. Paul's gospel in us causes Jesus; Jesus to overflow infinitely. Think of what He's done for us, and what this fulness of the gospel of Christ is doing in us for Him? Remember, we're His inheritance amen. By the grace of God Ephesians tells us; all of that what we're receiving from, Paul's gospel is for His good pleasure, so we know that this is His prize. This is the pearl of great price, this is His love, His dove, His fair one. All of this is true, it's real, and someday that faith is going to be made sight and we're thankful, and He tells us; He tells us very clearly, I'm going to make known to all that I love you; that's important to Me. That's the most important thing to Me; you're going to descend from heaven having My glory, My glory in your life honey. Your life because I'm the light of you. It's just incredible and I want to see Him tonight with you.

To be presented. I want you to think about this, Jesus to overflow infinitely. For Jesus to be presented complete and full He must have His wife. For Jesus to take the throne as God, the only things that's waiting is His wife completely made ready. Thank You Jesus, here we all come, hallelujah. So, this gospel in us readies our precious Saviour to take the throne from His Father. I pray we really see what the word of His grace has made you to Him, has made you for Him. The body as it says in Ephesians 1:23 that filleth all in all; that's Him in us. Now, I want you to go back with me. I'd like to just read that, I didn't mark that out but it said Ephesians 1:23, and we'd read this not too long ago, but read from verse twenty-two of Ephesians One, and this is about the Father hath put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be the head over all things to the church which is the body, the fulness of Him that filleth al in all.

See, there's a filling by the grace of God that the rib-portion body is going to bring to Him, and it does complete Jesus. It completes Him praise God in a fulness of overflowing that He even will even take the throne as God. This word tells us that we're everything to Him. It tells us brothers and sisters that we're essential; we're His good pleasure, we're His pearl of great price. I mentioned earlier we're His love, His dove, His fair one; His joint heir glorified together, exalted to the same glory with Him. And all I can say to that is yes, Christ in you, the hope of glory is very, very real. It's very, very true, and matter of fact it's of the utmost important. That's what He desires, that's what He has given.

Now, let's read on back in our text how clear this is in verses twenty-six and twenty-seven of Colossians here. We'll read from verse twenty-five where it says, wherefore I am made a minister according to the dispensation of God which is given to me for you to fulfil the word of God the mystery which is been hidden from ages, and from generations, and now is; and now is made manifest to His saints. How glorious. Now it's been made manifest to the people of God, now it's been made manifest to the sons of God to whom God; here's what it is would make known, this is the mystery what is the riches of the glory of this mystery which is this dispensation which is this wonderful message, this promise if you'll receive to fulfil the word of God, the riches of His glory of this mystery in the Gentiles, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

Now, praise the Lord, aren't you thankful that this has been made manifest to us. This has been made known to us, it's been revealed to us. It's here for the people of God who desire it. It's there, the word of God says I would that all men be saved and come to the full knowledge of Jesus Christ to have the knowledge of this mystery. But I thank the Lord the grace of God that's with us that has put a desire in our hearts to know this. And then His purpose in verse twenty-seven that He would make known the riches of His glory, that He would make known the height; pinnacle, the fulness of all this mystery in the saints in you. It's incredible, Christ in you the hope of glory. This is the glory that the word of God says that shall be revealed. This is the lampros glory that only the wife and the Lamb of God possess, and she again descends from heaven having the glory of God. Thank you, Jesus, this is what this is doing in them that believe. It's effectual, it's powerful and it overcomes everything. It overcomes doubt, it overcomes insult, it overcomes hurt, it overcomes failure; it overcomes everything.

Now, my heart by the grace of God has really led to focus on what does all this, and we know. We know it's this message. We know it's this dispensation that was given to Paul. We know by the grace of God it's this mystery that's been revealed, and we know all that is the word of His grace; the word of His grace does it all. Turn on over to Acts Chapter Twenty, verse thirty-two. This is a verse that we're very familiar with thank You Jesus. And Acts 20:32 Paul again speaking to the elders at Ephesus. This is the parting words, the last thing he says to them, and he says this in verse thirty-two. He says, and now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able; it's capable, it's strong, it's all powerful to build you up to make you this structure, this masterpiece. You read of her in the Song Of Solomon how that, oh my, the husband there he just magnifice her beauty, oh how beautiful; she's a tower, she's a palm tree, she's magnificent. So, this is what's able to build us up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified the same way that Paul says, and to all them also that love His appearing.

It's all there for you too, it's all there for me and we know by the grace of God it's them that love His appearing. 24:32 We know by the grace of God it's them that will just take the word of His grace, isn't that glorious? The word of His grace I commend you to that. Don't move from it; don't take anything else. It's either grace or it's works; you'll never bring those two together. Thank God for that article Brother Sheldon wrote. Actually, that was a message he gave, but the word of His grace is able. I mentioned, it's all powerful; it's capable, not you. No, Paul's gospel is what's capable; that's what's all fulfilling. It's knowing the love of Christ, it's knowing he dimensions; the height, the length, the breadth, the width; it's knowing it in every capacity that has got you, but it's for you that you can never be separated from that love. What love do you believe you could be separated from, from the love of God. I pray you wouldn't believe you could be separated from any of it. By the grace of God, I know I'll hold that fast which thou hast that no man take thy crown.

Well, I understand it very clearly, I'm confident in His love and loving His appearing, and it's the word of His grace. And if it's the word of His grace I know that He will keep that which I've committed unto Him against that day; I know He's the keeper of it. I know I am this little lily praise God that can't do a thing, I know that I am His workmanship. Oh hallelujah, I know that He will do it, and I know as we rejoiced on Sunday it is done. It's marvelous, is it not? It all comes back to the same thing, faith, believe me. Now, Paul's gospel is takeable; it's all by grace through faith. The word: the word does all the work in us. I Thessalonians 2:13 praise God the word works effectually in them that believe. Do you believe that? The word works all powerfully in them that believe. The word will get it done. The word will do it to them that believe. And why not brothers and sisters? The Word is His promise; the Word's His promise.

The promise of God, the one it's impossible for Him to lie. The word is His promise, what are you competent in. I pray nothing but the word of God, because the word of God is His promise, and that's what does it. Let's look at some verses that assure us. Going up all the way back to Numbers, Chapter twenty-three. Yes, Numbers twenty-three we get a wonderful verse out of here; many wonderful verses, but in verse nineteen God reminds us this, and listen to this. That's Numbers 23:19. God is not a man that He should lie. Did you hear that? See, that's why you got to quit thinking like a man; you understand that? Because we think like that then you're going to think that God doesn't mean what He says. See, God is God, His ways aren't our ways, His thoughts are not our thoughts. Thank You Jesus, our thoughts are earning, our thoughts are meriting. God's thoughts are grace, and God's thoughts are mercy. God's about one thing; love. For God so loved He gave. There wasn't any other motivator for what God did for us except love.

28:22

He just loved and it was love with no strings attached. I love you, just receive it, just believe it. You don't earn it, you don't merit it, you don't have to dance and sing for it, just receive it, it'll do all the work; it'll make you dance and sing. It'll make you want to. It's not have to, I want to, amen? I wanted to come tonight to be with you, I wanted to come tonight to rejoice in our heavenly bridegroom; how could I not? Because He put it in our hearts, it's the same reason you're here. I thank the Lord for that. There's no membership, there's no roll count, praise God. It's love. So, God is not a man that He should lie. Why? Just understand that, and know it, and thank Him every day for it. Neither the Son of man that He should repent. Isn't that beautiful? God doesn't make mistakes; God doesn't make mistakes. His love is not a mistake; He loves you, there's no mistake in that, okay?

And then, hath He said and shall He not do it? Think how beautiful that is, it's such a simple statement; hath not He said, and shall He not do it? Or hath He spoken it and shall He not make it good. See, that's the beautiful thing as well too. He speaks it, Who makes it good? He makes it good. Saints, you can't wiggle out of grace, you just can't. You can try to bend, you can try to do this, but it's grace. Just smile and thank Him, you know that it is and that's why I said earlier on, aren't you thankful you don't frustrate the

grace of God, you don't want to, and Lord if I start to do that. That's a wicked way, just correct it in me. Just grace, grace, grace, and the more grace, and yes, we'll praise Him for it. So, you see that again, God is not a man that He should lie, neither the Son of man that He should repent having said and shall He not do it, or hath He spoken and shall He not make it good, amen?

Let's go on, Joshua 21:45. These are beautiful gems to really rest in, trust in, build with your life in. That's Joshua 21:45. There failed not ought of any good thing which the Lord hath spoken unto the house of Israel; all came to pass, and God is not a respecter of persons. Jesus Christ the same yesterday, today, and forever. His promises praise the Lord are backed just the same; they're assured, and He chose you because He loves you, and He will, nothing will fail any good thing that the Lord has spoken unto the house of Israel, and here we got a better thing. And what He's spoken to you; it will not fail; all came to pass. It will come to pass, why do you think He said call those things which be not as though they were, amen? This is our truth, praise God, yes, the Old Testament were promises to Israel, but the layers of the encouragement to us; oh, my. The bridal message sown in this, praise God. The prophets wanted to look in deeper to what really was there. We understand it's for Israel, but boy there's something underneath that, and that was for us. And they wrote those things for us. Rejoice, and again I say rejoice.

Alright, let's go to Isaiah 55:11, one our favorites. But thank the Lord in context of this, and what the Lord has assured us. Oh, let it be a full joy, and not just a full joy, but a full joy to Jesus that it will fulfil His joy. We'll read about that praise God and rejoice if the Lord tarry on Sunday as we go on in the crown. And let me tell you something, the crown life is a joy of a life.; joyful. Isaiah 55:11. So shall My word be that goeth forth out of my mouth, it shall not return unto Me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing where to I sent it. Think of what He sent you. I think about each and every one of us, and I see my brother Paul back there saying thank You Lord Jesus. That brother's with many years wonderful men of God. That love the Lord. Unquestionable, but God sent Paul's gospel to that brother, and it's accomplishing what the Lord pleases, what pleases Him is going to prosper in the thing which I sent it. That's what He's doing in your life.

That's why it's bubbling over, that's why if you ask the Lord, what can I do for you except to take the cup of salvation and drink, become more wise to this, and thankful for what you have chosen me for; what You've kept me in. Lord, I did turn away because You held me in this by Your faithfulness. It's everything saints, everything. Go on to Romans Chapter Four, verse twenty-one. We're almost done here. We could go to so many more verses, but Romans 4:21. And being fully persuaded that what He had promised He was able also to perform. And praise God, that encouragement came through the Father of us all. Abraham. And I'll tell you, God really promised Him amazing, wonderful things, didn't He? Things that were absolutely impossible. Things, where he would look at the outward appearance of himself as a hundred-year-old man and looking at His sweet wife

who was basically almost the same age as him with a dead womb. Well honey, we're going to have a baby. And what could she do but laugh? Abraham, I love you, but you're nuts. But He believed God.

36:10

And how many people have looked at your life and said you're nuts if you think you're going to attain to the bride. You're nuts that you think that you could ever be the wife to the Lamb of God. You're too, see, she was beyond that she could ever have it. Do you know that's sometimes in how legalists will look at you? you could never have it. Because I'll tell you one thing, I follow policy to follow Christ, and I believe the call Him the chiefest sinner. And I believe even after thirty some years of being encouraged of the Lord we get to a thing called Romans Chapter Seven, and he still at the one point in his life, and you know that point was many times, oh Lord I know, and what I have in my heart what You are to me, and yet the good that I would I'm still not doing, and the evil that I would not, I'm doing that. Wretched man that I am. Paul, you got it, Now, you've got it.

Now, go on over to Philippians 1:6. So, we know that He'll perform it, amen because He promised, and He's the good work that He began. Remember, we didn't choose Him, He chose us. Jesus told that to the disciples, you didn't choose Me, I chose you. We love Him because He first loved us, and here's such a beautiful encouragement to us. Being confident of this very thing, that He which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ. Are you confident? Well, how dare you be confident? You hear that don't you when you believe in the grace of God, and you say the grace of God will do it. Well, you'd better not be that confident. It tells me to be confident of the very thing; of the very thing that He which hath begun a good work in me will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ.

Now I press toward the mark of the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus, and I understand that I have not yet apprehended, but I'm apprehended for it. I'm apprehended of Him for it. So, I'm being confident. I'm being confident, I'm resting, I'm trusting; I cease from my own works. I know this isn't about works, I know this isn't about good deeds. I know this is about faith. I know this is about loving the appearing of my Husband Jesus. And so, I'm being confident. Not in Jesse, but in the grace of God that's with me. He wouldn't give this to me if He wasn't going to accomplish it, He wouldn't give this to me if He weren't going to perform it. This is for His pleasure; thank You Lord. Being confident of this very thing that He which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ. Isn't that glorious? Again, He put it in you, He performs it all, He's going to finish it, He guarantees it, and all He asks is, just be confident in it. Isn't that beautiful?

Hold that fast which thou hast. I'm not trying to get anything; I already got it. I already got it, hallelujah., I've got it all. There isn't any more of it I could have because I'm blessed with all spiritual blessings in the heavens in Christ, The Holy Ghost by the grace of God did exactly what the Holy Ghost said He would do. He would take all the things of

Christ and show them to me, show them to you, and show you that you have them; you have them. Are you going to be like this precious sister in Luke One, verse forty-five speaking of Mary as Elizabeth testified to her? And blessed is she, blessed are you that believe, and she hasn't even had the baby yet. It's done; it's done because she believed. Blessed because of faith, for there shall be a performance of those thigs which were told her from the Lord, and He doesn't do it any other way because he that hath an ear, let him hear, and He gave you the ear to hear it, and you heard it. And by the grace of God, He gave you the grace to believe it. And that grace has caused the confidence. 41:45

So, do we see the faithfulness of God's great grace in our lives? Full overcomers believe it's the word that performs everything. And I close with this, I told you that was sweet, one of the sisters gave Polly and I these little lily seeds okay, and just the seed, all these little, tiny seeds, and you know we see every Sunday, or many Sundays I should say those beautiful lilies; there's nothing like them. The bible says Solomon wasn't even arrayed like one of them. But in that little, tiny seed once again all the beauty is there. Every bit of the glory of what that will be is all there. Alright? every bit of it. Now, stay with me. So, we were given those seeds, and we took those seeds, and we planted those seeds. And we planted them in full sunlight because that's what you're supposed to do with a lily, full sunlight. Not partial, not most of the time sun; that doesn't work, it's got to be full just like Paul's full gospel. This is what we're talking about. Paul's gospel is nothing of works, nothing of man's ways, it's nothing of man's stupidity, it's just the word of His grace; that's what it is.

And we thank the Lord that you plant that in your life you'll be arrayed more than any beauty than Solomon was arrayed in. But I want you to think about that. That seed did not do a thing; it did not do a thing. I planted it, I watered it, I fed it, I tended to its every need and man are they beautiful, and that's you. And that's what grace is. Everything we are He planted. Everything that we are is because we are His workmanship, and he will do it all. And I thank the Lord we want that glory with Him. We want what we read tonight by the grace of God, we want the glory that fulfills our precious Bridegroom Jesus, and that's only grace, and all I can say is we're the wonder of His love. Even so Lord, come. Thank You Lord Jesus, that's quite a fullness is it not? And it is, praise God. Let's stand and be dismissed.
